

Machine Maintenance II

Position Purpose

To maintain all production equipment, and fabricate, by machining, replacement parts for all production machines.

Requirements

- ❑ Must have a minimum of 5 years machine shop experience, or completion of a recognized machinist apprenticeship program.
- ❑ Must possess good mechanical aptitude and mechanical background in order to locate and repair machining problems.
- ❑ Must be able to braze, silver solder, and arc weld.
- ❑ Must be physically capable of standing up to 12 hours.
- ❑ Must be able to read, write, and do basic arithmetic functions in order to read blue prints and make mathematical calculations.
- ❑ Individual must successfully complete an initial program of classroom instruction regarding the nature of handling, storage, and treatment of hazardous material including all pertinent regulations. Continuing on the job training on the subject will be done when deemed necessary by Supervisor or when new materials or regulations are introduced. This training must include emergency response procedures including shutdown of operations.
- ❑ Must provide own hand tools including machinist's precision tools and mechanic's tools.
- ❑ Must be willing and able to work varying hours, including nights and weekends.
- ❑ Requires the ability to climb and work from ladders up to 20 ft in order to access machinery.
- ❑ Must be able to work in close proximity to oils, solvents, and chemicals used in production equipment.
- ❑ Must be mentally alert to constant hazards of machinery and chemicals.
- ❑ Must be able to lift 25 lbs frequently, with a maximum of 75 lbs occasionally.
- ❑ Must be able to work in factory environment with noise from machines running, and in temperatures up to 110 degrees.

Hazardous Waste Management

May be responsible for managing hazardous waste at the point of generation in accordance with generator waste accumulation requirements. Responsible for following procedures in the Wright & McGill Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency plan.
